January 2010 minutes approved.

President: Phil Dahl reports that consolidation efforts are ongoing. Spring ACL league still not for sure, but the WSA in Camas has a league going.

Vice President: Ryan Blonien, not present, no report.

Secretary: POSITION OPEN, please ask clubs to look for volunteer.

Treasurer: Sarah Dahl – She presented bills for \$37.20 for pizza and pop to Phil Dahl for the Feb. 3rd consolidation meeting and \$60.00 to Sarah Dahl for one year PO Box rental. Spring insurance bill to WSYSA for \$1,194.93 for players registered in January. MSA to pay these bills and approve the treasurer's report as presented.

VP Operation: Gayle Paavola has resigned the position. Please look to the clubs for a new volunteer.

VP Development: Dennis Pelton reports that a meeting was held with Jeff Enquist (United Soccer Academy) to plan summer clinics. The dates will be June 28 – July 2, July 12 – July 16, and Aug. 16 – Aug. 20 from 10:00 – 3:00 each day. A goalie camp will be held during one of these three weeks. On the last Friday, August 20th, there will be an evening coach's clinic for all area coaches. Soren Popovich will offer goalie training on Tuesdays and Thursdays during the month of July. Timber Barons Jamboree will be held on Saturday June 5th. Tri-Mountain and Chinook will bring teams to Longview for the one-day event, two games guaranteed. Cost is \$30 per game per team, to cover referee costs (centers will make \$30 per game and AR's \$15).

MAR REP: Tom Hutchinson – not present, no report.

CLUBS:

Castle Rock: Joe Shulke reports that they are still looking for more volunteers for the board.

Kalama: Not present – no report.

Kelso: Morgan Aberle reports that they will meet tomorrow. Also open registration dates for spring rec soccer are tomorrow Tuesday Feb. 16th from 5:00 – 7:00 at the Tamo Clubhouse and on Saturday Feb. 20th from 10:00 – 2:00 at Coweeman Middle School.

Longview: Jeff Tollefson reports that there is news about the Cowlitz County Expo Center being considered for some government grant money, and Proposal B would involve a full-size outdoor soccer field as well as an indoor soccer facility. Soccer families are asked to contact County Commissioner Axel Swanson with your support for Proposal B.

Longview Soccer Club maintenance department is requesting additional funds for the job: the original 20-hour per week position has often needed 40 or more hours a week to complete. It can take 40 hours a week just to mow the whole 8 full-size fields.

Cowlitz Kick-off tournament will be held August 6 – 8, 2010. Jeff would like to review who benefits from this tournament, as mostly select teams participate but are now registered through CYSA. So far no funds are going to CYSA though, they are kept by LSC as a club fundraiser.

Laura Gressett reports that Longview Soccer Club will offer an entry-level referee clinic March 18 – 21, 2010 for ages 14 and up (13-year-olds can take the class with a parent who is also being certified). Laura would like to recommend that CYSA not pay for referee recertification for all refs forever, but rather reimburse the \$50 fee the first year, and maybe \$25 the second year, and then have the referees responsible for the fee from then on. CYSA does not have the funds to continue to take care of this for all referees.

Ocean Beach: Not present – no report.

Rainier/Clatskanie: Not present – no report.

CYSA VP Competition/Recreation: Brie Oestreich reports that she will try to accommodate as many special requests from spring coaches as possible. Send those requests to her as soon as possible. She will be out of town during spring break so she is hoping to finish the spring rec schedule by the end of March.

VP Competition/Select: Meredith Ellis reports that all select coaches (new or returning) need to reapply for this spring, it serves as a “letter of intent” so that CYSA knows who is coaching at what age level. Javier Cacaes will not return to coach the BU13 (now 14) team this fall. Harlan Crusier will not coach the GU14 team from last fall and will continue to coach at the GU19 level.

Timber Barons: Teresa Aloe not present; no report. Select tryout dates were set: May 1 and 2, 2010: 3:00 – 5:00 for BU11 and 12, GU11 and 12, and BU16 and up and May 8 and 9, 2010: 3:00 – 5:00 for GU13 – 15 and up and BU13 – 15. A select coach's information night will be held in late April before the tryouts.
